Short Biography

As a national recording artist and professional entertainer, Cash Backman has been in the forefront of the Australian country / rock industry for two decades and since the release of the radio hit 'My Girl Bill' early in his career, has continued to notch up an impressive list of awards and salutation. His new album "Thirty Years On" sees Cash back at his best! Truly re-establishing himself as an impressive singer-songwriter of an international standard.

In the mid-seventies, he became the first Australian country / rock artist to top the pop charts and as a result of that, became a much sought after club & concert performer, guest starring with many international acts namely: Roy Orbison, Phyllis Diller, Frankie Valli and the Four Seasons, The Drifters, Dobie Gray, along with Local stars Marcia Hines, and The Seekers.

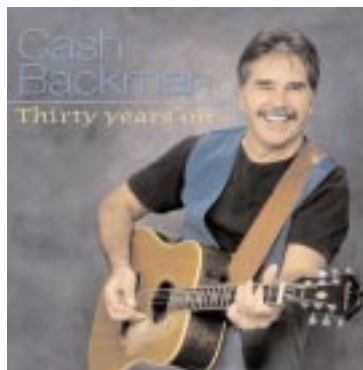
Cash has appeared countless times on many television variety and music shows, including: The Mike Walsh Show, Don Lane Show, Paul Hogan Show, Reg Lindsay's Country Homestead, ABC's Country Roads (which he compared as well), Lee Conway Show, The Bert Newton Show, Good Morning Australia, Denise, and was a regular on In Melbourne Today.

In 1990, organisers of an annual American Festival known as 'Memphis In May' invited Cash to perform at several of their outdoor concerts. In three shows he performed to over 150,000 Memphians; on all occasions receiving encores and recognised as the "most popular performer" in the Festival's eight year history.

Late '95 saw Cash performing in Hong Kong for Austrade. This led to two more visits in '96, working the American Club circuit.

Cash has the impressive claim as a singer/songwriter to have had his songs recorded in Australia, Europe, South Africa, New Zealand, England and America.

His unique style enthralled audiences wherever he performs and with ten albums to his credit, including his latest, "30 Years On", he has stood the test-of-time and proven to be an entertainer of substance and longevity.



The collection of songs on "Thirty Years On" is probably Cash's strongest ever songwriting and was written over a period of years. The songs show Cash's depth and perception lyrically which comes from time and experience as a songwriter.

Cash plans with this album to get back to the grass roots as a performer by getting out live regularly to promote the CD.
